Subject : Notice of Suspension

Kristopher Arrey,

On June 30, 2019, the USFL Board of Directors conducted a disciplinary board meeting stemming from four written reports from four USFL officials regarding incidents involving you during the U.S. National Championships in Ontario, California on June 22, 2019.

All four reports document numerous incidents of poor conduct or conduct that violates the USFL code of conduct ranging from using foul language to several adults (coaches and parents) and other athlete(s), making threats of violence, and also taunting athletes during and after the U.S. National Championships on June 22, 2019. USFL officials are able to enforce the code of conduct to all licensees within the competition enclosure and within the entire competition venue.

After careful consideration from the written reports and personal recollections by board members of inappropriate behavior at this event and past incidents of inappropriate behavior at other events, the Board of Directors returned a unanimous decision to impose a period of suspension for you. The proposed suspension period is 90 days with 1 year probation. Even though the Board of Director's vote was unanimous, one board member stated that your inappropriate behavior and un-sportsman like conduct was manipulated by others. Nevertheless, as a USFL licensee, it is expected that you conduct yourself according to the expectations of USFL code of conduct, and since you did not, the result is the imposition of your suspension.

According to the USFL bylaws, you have 10 days to formally appeal this suspension or provide other written statements and evidence contradicting these acts you are being accused of. Please note all officials and Board Members are extremely supportive of you and invested in your potential to make a major impact in the MMA industry, as well as in society. Collectively, they view these actions as corrective and constructive in helping you achieve your long term goals.
